COVID-19 Disease Emergency (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2020

## NOTICE UNDER SECTIONS 14 AND 16

- I, PETER CARL GUTWEIN, the Premier, being of the opinion that the relevant emergency circumstances exist in relation to this notice and with the approval of the emergency manager —
- (a) in pursuance of section 14 of the *COVID-19 Disease Emergency* (*Miscellaneous Provisions*) *Act 2020*, amend, for the period for which this notice has effect under that Act, each provision that specifies the period for which a permit is in effect, that
  - (i) is contained in a permit that is issued under section 143, 169, 193 or 260 of the *Building Act 2016* ("the Act") or that is contained in a permit that is taken to be issued under the Act by virtue of clause 6 of Part 3 of Schedule 2 to the Act; and
  - (ii) is in effect immediately before the day on which the making of this notice is published in the *Gazette* –

by extending the period specified in the provision so that the period ends 6 months after the day on which, but for this notice, the period would end; and

- (b) in pursuance of section 16 of the *COVID-19 Disease Emergency* (*Miscellaneous Provisions*) *Act 2020*, extend, for the period of 6 months after the day on which, but for this notice, the period would end, the period for which a permit that
  - (i) is issued under section 143, 169, 193 or 260 of the Act or that is taken to be issued under the Act by virtue of clause 6 of Part 3 of Schedule 2 to the Act; and
  - (ii) is in effect immediately before the day on which the making of this notice is published in the *Gazette* –

is in effect by virtue of a provision of the Act.
