**An Act to amend the *National Trust Preservation Fund  
(Winding-up) Act 1999***

**[Royal Assent 5 September 2017]**

Be it enacted by Her Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

**1. Short title**

This Act may be cited as the *National Trust Preservation Fund (Winding-up) Amendment Act 2017*.

**2. Commencement**

This Act commences on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent.

**3. Principal Act**

In this Act, the *National Trust Preservation Fund (Winding-up) Act 1999\** is referred to as the Principal Act.

**4. Section 3 amended (Interpretation)**

Section 3 of the Principal Act is amended as follows:

- (a) by inserting the following definition after the definition of *Heritage Fund*:

*planning scheme* means a planning scheme within the meaning of the *Land Use Planning and Approvals Act 1993*;

- (b) by omitting the definition of *National Trust*.

**5. Section 5 amended (Distribution of funds)**

Section 5(3) of the Principal Act is amended as follows:

- (a) by omitting “an entry in” and substituting “places in the city of Hobart that are”;
- (b) by omitting paragraphs (a) and (b) and substituting the following paragraphs:

- (a) heritage listed under a planning scheme in effect in that city; or
- (b) entered in the Tasmanian Heritage Register.

**6. Repeal of Act**

This Act is repealed on the three hundred and sixty fifth day from the day on which it commences.
