STATUTORY HOLIDAYS AMENDMENT ACT 2022

No. 24 of 2022

An Act to amend the *Statutory Holidays Act 2000* to provide for a statutory holiday for a National Day of Mourning to pay respect for the passing of Her Majesty, Queen Elizabeth II

[Royal Assent 17 October 2022]

Be it enacted by Her Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Statutory Holidays Amendment Act 2022*.

2. Commencement

- (1) Except as provided by this section, the provisions of this Act are taken to have commenced on 11 September 2022.

(2) Section 5 commences on 31 December 2022.

3. Principal Act

In this Act, the *Statutory Holidays Act 2000** is referred to as the Principal Act.

4. Section 4 amended (Statutory holidays)

Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by inserting after paragraph (h) the following paragraph:

(ha) 22 September 2022, for a National Day of Mourning to pay respect for the passing of Her Majesty, Queen Elizabeth II;

5. Section 4 further amended (Statutory holidays)

Section 4 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting paragraph (ha).

6. Repeal of Act

This Act is repealed on 31 December 2023.
