APPROPRIATION ACT (No. 2) 2026

No. 8 of 2026

An Act for the appropriation of \$62 913 000 out of the Public Account for the services of the Government in respect of Parliament and Statutory Offices for the financial year ending on 30 June 2027

[Royal Assent 10 July 2026]

Be it enacted by Her Excellency the Governor of Tasmania, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and House of Assembly, in Parliament assembled, as follows:

1. Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Appropriation Act (No. 2) 2026*.

2. Commencement

This Act commences on 1 July 2026, but if it does not receive the Royal Assent by that date

this Act is taken to have commenced on 1 July 2026.

3. Interpretation

For the purposes of this Act –

Capital Services means –

- (a) public works or property required for public purposes; or
- (b) a loan authorised by law;

Operating Services means the ordinary annual services of the Government.

4. Issue, application and appropriation of \$62 913 000

- (1) In respect of the financial year ending on 30 June 2027, the Treasurer may –
 - (a) issue the sum of \$62 913 000 out of the Public Account; and
 - (b) apply that sum for the services of the Government.
- (2) The sum specified in subsection (1)(a) is appropriated.

5. Purposes of appropriation

The sum specified in section 4(1)(a) is to be applied for the purposes specified in Schedule 1 and detailed in the agency information in support

6. Expiry of Act

This Act expires on 30 June 2028.
