1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Traffic (Electronic Billboards) Regulations 2018*.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on the day on which their making is notified in the *Gazette*.

3. Prescribed device

For the purposes of section 77(2)(b) of the *Traffic Act 1925*, a device is a prescribed device if the device is –

- (a) displaying, either constantly or intermittently and with or without variation, illuminated words or images; and
- (b) placed or left on a public street, or in a public place, by a police officer for traffic management, road safety or law enforcement purposes.
