#### 1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Operations) Amendment Regulations 2018.

#### 2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on the day on which their making is notified in the *Gazette*.

## 3. Principal Regulations

In these regulations, the *Vehicle and Traffic* (*Vehicle Operations*) *Regulations 2014\** are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

## 4. Regulation 10 amended (Width)

Regulation 10(2) of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting paragraph (g) and substituting the following paragraphs:

- (g) tyre pressure gauges;
- (h) permanently affixed webbing assemblytype devices if the width of the vehicle including those devices does not exceed 2.55 metres.
