1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the
*Ambulance Service (Paramedic) Amendment
Regulations 2018*.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on the day on
which their making is notified in the *Gazette*.

3. Principal Regulations

In these regulations, the *Ambulance Service (Paramedic) Regulations 2014** are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

4. Regulations 4 and 5 inserted

After regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations, the following regulations are inserted:

4. Prescribed paramedics

A person registered under the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law (Tasmania) in the paramedic profession is a prescribed person for the purposes of section 3AB(c) of the *Ambulance Service Act 1982*, while he or she is so registered.

5. Interstate ambulance services

For the purposes of section 3AB(b) of the *Ambulance Service Act 1982*, each of the following interstate ambulance services are a prescribed ambulance service of another jurisdiction:

- (a) the Ambulance Service of NSW within the meaning of the *Health Services Act 1997* of New South Wales;
- (b) the Ambulance Service – Victoria within the meaning of the

Ambulance Services Act 1986 of
Victoria;

- (c) the Queensland Ambulance Service established under section 3A of the *Ambulance Service Act 1991* of Queensland;
- (d) the SA Ambulance Service Inc continued in existence under section 49 of the *Health Care Act 2008* of South Australia;
- (e) the ACT Ambulance Service established under section 40 of the *Emergencies Act 2004* of the Australian Capital Territory;
- (f) St John Ambulance Western Australia Ltd (ABN 55 028 468 715);
- (g) St John Ambulance Australia NT Inc (ABN 85 502 986 808).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the regulations)

These regulations amend the *Ambulance Service (Paramedic) Regulations 2014* by specifying that the following persons are paramedics for the purposes of the *Ambulance Service Act 1982*:

- (a) paramedics employed by certain interstate ambulance services;
- (b) persons holding registration in the paramedic profession.
