1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Anatomical Examinations Amendment Regulations 2019*.

3. Principal Regulations

In these regulations, the *Anatomical Examinations Regulations 2017** are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

4. Regulation 14 amended (Fee for application for authorisation to undertake anatomical examinations)

Regulation 14 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting “55 fee units, inclusive of GST” and substituting “50 fee units”.
