This notice may be cited as the *Strategic Infrastructure Corridors* (*Strategic and Recreational Use*) (*Transfer of Railway Infrastructure - Turners Marsh to Lilydale*) *Notice* 2020.

2. Commencement

This notice takes effect on 27 March 2020.

3. Transfer of rail infrastructure

All rail infrastructure that is situated on the corridor named the North East Corridor from Turners Marsh to Lilydale is transferred to the Crown.
