1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Economic Regulator Regulations 2020*.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on 26 May 2020.

3. Fee for lodging complaint

- (1) For the purpose of section 49(c) of the *Economic Regulator Act 2009*, the prescribed fee is 110 fee units, inclusive of GST.
- (2) For the purposes of subregulation (1), **GST** has the same meaning as in the *A New Tax System (Goods and Services Tax) Act 1999* of the Commonwealth.
