1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Police Offences Amendment Regulations 2020*.

2. Commencement

3. Principal Regulations

In these regulations, the *Police Offences Regulations 2014** are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

4. Regulation 7A amended (Identified organisations for purposes of section 6A(3) of Act)

Regulation 7A of the Principal Regulations is amended as follows:

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (e) “Henchmen.” and substituting “Henchmen;”;
- (b) by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (e):
 - (f) the motorcycle club known as Nomads.
