1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Community Protection (Offender Reporting) Amendment Regulations 2020*.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on the day on which their making is notified in the *Gazette*.

3. Principal Regulations

In these regulations, the *Community Protection (Offender Reporting) Regulations 2016** are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

4. Regulation 6 amended (Corresponding offender reporting orders)

Regulation 6 of the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting after paragraph (f) the following paragraph:

- (fa) a child sex offender registration order under the *Child Sex Offenders Registration Act 2006* of South Australia;

5. Regulations rescinded

These regulations are rescinded on the first anniversary of the day on which they took effect.
