**1. Short title**

These regulations may be cited as the *Inland Fisheries Amendment Regulations 2020*.

**2. Commencement**

These regulations take effect on the seventh day after the day on which their making is notified in the *Gazette*.

**3. Principal Regulations**

In these regulations, the *Inland Fisheries Regulations 2019\** are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

**4. Regulation 7 amended (Taking fish from inland waters)**

Regulation 7(3)(a) of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting subparagraph (i).

**5. Regulation 35A inserted**

After regulation 35 of the Principal Regulations, the following regulation is inserted in Part 4:

**35A. Eel royalties**

- (1) The holder of a commercial freshwater fishing licence must pay to the Director a royalty for eel taken under the authority of that commercial freshwater fishing licence.
- (2) The royalty payable by the holder of a commercial freshwater fishing licence under subregulation (1) –
  - (a) is to be calculated at 0.25 fee units per kilogram of eel taken under the licence; and

- (b) is due and payable within 30 days after the day on which an invoice for the royalty is issued in writing by the Director.
- (3) The Director may refuse to renew a commercial freshwater fishing licence if the holder of the licence has not paid the royalty payable in respect of that licence under this regulation.
