1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Health* (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2020.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on 30 September 2020.

Principal Regulations 3.

In these regulations, the *Health* (Fees) Regulations 2017* are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations amend the *Health (Fees) Regulations 2017* by increasing certain fees that may be charged in respect of non-nursing-home-type patients for certain hospital services.
