### **1. Short title**

These regulations may be cited as the *Corrections Amendment Regulations 2020*.

### **2. Commencement**

These regulations take effect on the day on which their making is notified in the *Gazette*.

**3. Principal Regulations**

In these regulations, the *Corrections Regulations 2018\** are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

**4. Regulation 34A inserted**

After regulation 34 of the Principal Regulations, the following regulation is inserted in Part 6:

**34A. Prescribed offences**

For the purposes of the definition of *terrorism offence* in Division 2A of Part 8 of the Act, the following offences in relation to terrorism are prescribed:

- (a) an offence under section 310J of the *Crimes Act 1900* of New South Wales;
- (b) an offence under section 4B of the *Terrorism (Community Protection) Act 2003* of Victoria.
