1. Short title

These Rules of Court may be cited as the *Supreme Court Amendment Rules 2021*.

2. Commencement

These Rules of Court take effect on the day on which their making is notified in the *Gazette*.

3. Principal Rules

In these Rules of Court, the *Supreme Court Rules 2000** are referred to as the Principal Rules.

4. Rule 20 amended (Office hours)

Rule 20 of the Principal Rules is amended by omitting subrule (1) and substituting the following subrule:

- (1) Subject to any direction published by the Principal Registrar, each registry is to be open from 9 am until 4.30 pm on every day in the year except Saturdays, Sundays and Court holidays.
