TRAFFIC (COMPLIANCE AND ENFORCEMENT) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 2021

1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Traffic* (Compliance and Enforcement) Amendment Regulations 2021.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on the day on which the *Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2021* commence.

3. Principal Regulations

In these regulations, the *Traffic (Compliance and Enforcement) Regulations 2017** are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

4. Regulation 3 amended (Interpretation)

Regulation 3(1) of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting the definition of *DLVR* and substituting the following definition:

DLVR means the Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2021;

5. Regulation 4 substituted

Regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations is rescinded and the following regulation is substituted:

4. Prescribed offences for section 9(3) of Act

For section 9(3) of the Act, a parking offence is a prescribed offence.

6. Regulation 5 amended (Prescribed offences for section 43H of Act)

Regulation 5 of the Principal Regulations is amended by omitting paragraph (c) and substituting the following paragraph:

(c) an offence under regulation 12(2) or (3) of the Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2021.

7. Regulation 7 amended (Specified offences for section 54(1AA) of Act)

Regulation 7 of the Principal Regulations is amended as follows:

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (c) "Vehicle and Traffic Act 1999;" and substituting "Vehicle and Traffic Act 1999.";
- (b) by omitting paragraph (d).
