### **1. Short title**

These regulations may be cited as the *Collections for Charities Regulations 2021*.

### **2. Commencement**

These regulations take effect on 17 August 2021.

### **3. Interpretation**

In these regulations –

*Act* means the *Collections for Charities Act 2001*.

**4. Authorised soliciting by religious organisations**

For the purposes of section 4(j) of the Act, soliciting by a religious organisation, by way of an appeal to its adherents or any other person who has attended a religious service held by that organisation, is authorised.
