1. Short title

These Rules of Court may be cited as the
Justices (Review) Amendment Rules 2021.

2. Commencement

These Rules of Court take effect on the day on
which their making is notified in the *Gazette*.

3. Principal Rules

In these Rules of Court, the *Justices (Review) Rules 2004** are referred to as the Principal Rules.

4. Rule 6 amended (Notice to review)

Rule 6 of the Principal Rules is amended by omitting subrule (1) and substituting the following subrule:

- (1) A notice to review is to be made returnable on a Wednesday in a sittings to be held at the place nearest to the court from which the appeal is brought.
