3. Principal Regulations

In these regulations, the *Justices Regulations 2013** are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

4. Regulation 3 amended (Fees)

Regulation 3 of the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting after subregulation (2) the following subregulation:

- (3) Despite subregulation (1), a fee set out in Schedule 1 is not payable in respect of an application under the *Family Violence Act 2004*.
