**PROCLAMATION UNDER THE NATURE
CONSERVATION ACT 2002**

STATUTORY RULES 2022, No. 36

I, the Governor in and over the State of Tasmania and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, by this my proclamation made under section 11(2) of the *Nature Conservation Act 2002* –

- (a) declare the area of Crown land specified in Schedule 1 to this proclamation to be reserved land in the class of conservation area; and
- (b) give the name Seymour Conservation Area to that reserved land; and
- (c) declare that this proclamation takes effect on the day on which its making is notified in the *Gazette*.

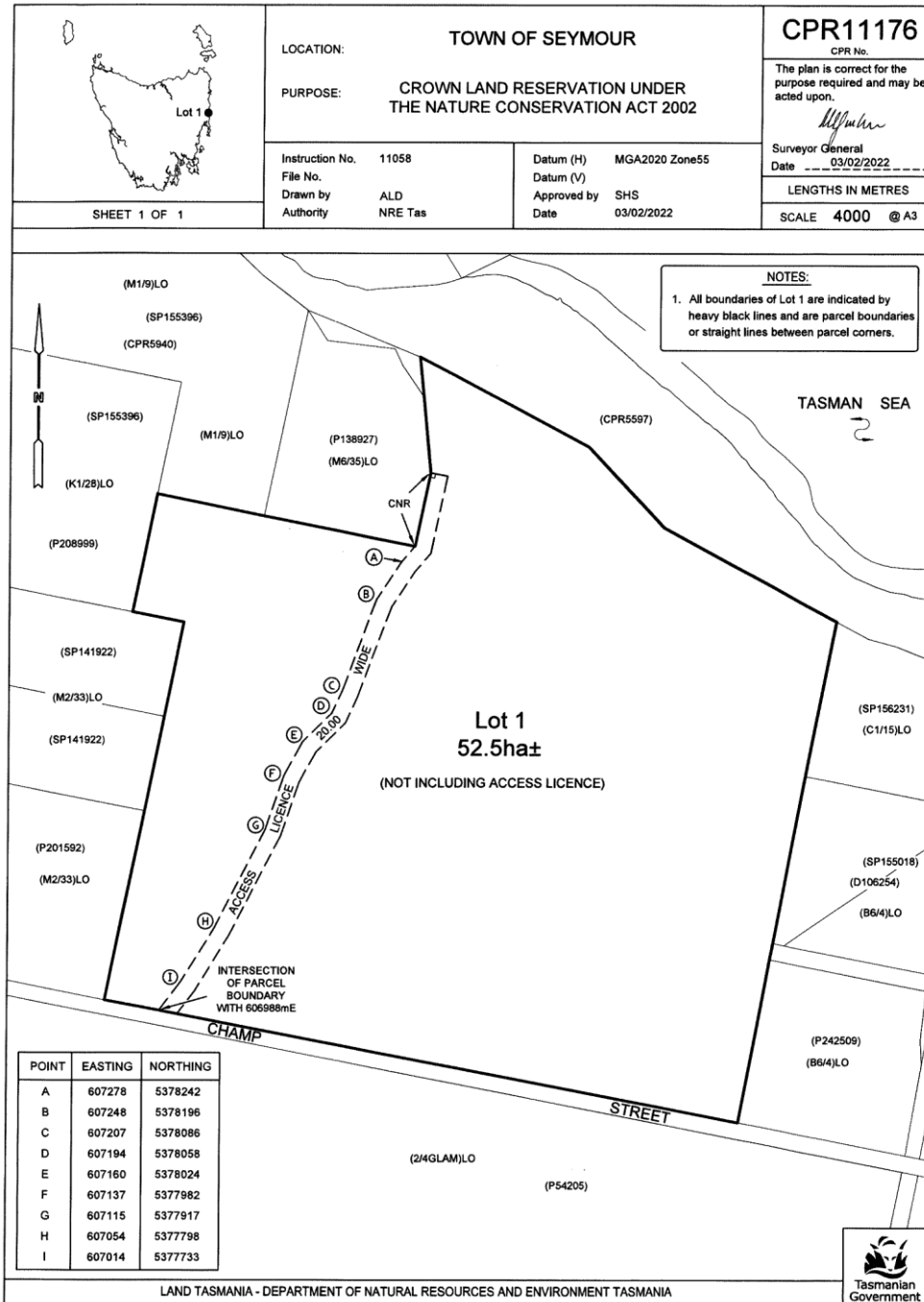
SCHEDULE 1 – SEYMOUR CONSERVATION AREA
