(No. 6) 2022

1. Short title

This order may be cited as the *State Service (Restructuring) Order (No. 6) 2022*.

2. Commencement

This order takes effect on 1 October 2022.

3. Amalgamations

- (1) The part of the Department of Treasury and Finance known as Renewables, Climate and Future Industries Tasmania is amalgamated with the Department of State Growth.
- (2) The following parts of the Department of Communities Tasmania are amalgamated with the Department for Education, Children and Young People:
 - (a) the Office of Commissioner for Children and Young People;
 - (b) the part known as Children, Youth and Families;
 - (c) the Tasmanian Autism Diagnostic Service;
 - (d) the Inquiry Support Unit;
 - (e) the Child Advocate.
- (3) The part of the Department of Communities Tasmania known as the Board of Exceptional Needs is amalgamated with the Department of Health.
- (4) The following parts of the Department of Communities Tasmania are amalgamated with the Department of Premier and Cabinet:
 - (a) the Tasmanian Community Fund;
 - (b) the part known as Community and Disability Services.
