1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Poisons Amendment Regulations (No. 3) 2023*.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on the day on which their making is notified in the *Gazette*.

3. Principal Regulations

In these regulations, the *Poisons Regulations 2018** are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

4. Regulation 24 amended (Prescription for certain narcotic substances to be issued only on authority of Secretary)

Regulation 24 of the Principal Regulations is amended as follows:

- (a) by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (l):
 - (la) N, α -dimethyl-3,4-(methylenedioxy)methamphetamine (MDMA);
- (b) by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (n):
 - (na) psilocybine;
