This order may be cited as the *Threatened Species Protection Order 2024*.

2. Commencement

This order takes effect on the day on which its making is notified in the *Gazette*.

3. Principal Act

In this order, the *Threatened Species Protection Act 1995** is referred to as the Principal Act.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the order)

This order amends the *Threatened Species Protection Act 1995* by –

- (a) adding certain species to, and omitting certain species from, the Schedules of endangered, vulnerable and rare flora and fauna; and
- (b) updating certain taxonomic, authority and common name references in those Schedules.
