1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Security and Investigations Agents Regulations 2025*.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on
23 December 2025.

3. Interpretation

In these regulations, unless the contrary intention appears –

Act means the *Security and Investigations Agents Act 2002*.

4. Infringement offences and penalties

- (1) The offences against a section of the Act specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 are prescribed as infringement offences.
- (2) The penalty specified in column 3 of Schedule 1 in relation to an infringement offence is the penalty payable under an infringement notice issued and served for that infringement offence.

5. Fees

The fees set out in Schedule 2 are the fees prescribed for the purposes of the Act.
