3. Declaration of interstate DVO

For the purposes of section 6(1)(h) of the *Domestic Violence Orders (National Recognition) Act 2016*, a police protection direction under the *Domestic and Family Violence Protection Act 2012* of Queensland is declared to be an interstate DVO.

4. Legislation rescinded

The legislation specified in Schedule 1 is rescinded.
