**PROCLAMATION UNDER THE ROADS AND
JETTIES ACT 1935**

STATUTORY RULES 2026, No. 13

I, the Governor in and over the State of Tasmania and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, by this my proclamation made under section 7 of the *Roads and Jetties Act 1935* declare that –

- (a) the portion of road specified in Schedule 1 to this proclamation ceases to be a State highway for the purposes of Part II of that Act; and
- (b) this proclamation takes effect on the day on which its making is notified in the *Gazette*.


**SCHEDULE 1 – PORTION OF ROAD CEASING TO BE

South Road	From a point approximately 62.5 metres west of the centre of its junction with Hearps Road to approximately 165.5 metres west of that point, shown as the shaded area on Plan 11617 in the Central Plan Register, a reduced copy of which is set out, by way of illustration only, in Schedule 2 to this proclamation	0.103 kilometres
