1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Historic Cultural Heritage Regulations 2026*.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on 17 August 2026.

3. Interpretation

In these regulations –

Act means the *Historic Cultural Heritage Act 1995*;

GST has the same meaning as in the *A New Tax System (Goods and Services Tax) Act 1999* of the Commonwealth.

4. Application fee for unregistered place certificate

For section 78(2)(c) of the Act, the prescribed fee is 25 fee units, inclusive of GST.

5. Application fee for affected place certificate

For section 86(2)(c) of the Act, the prescribed fee is 25 fee units, inclusive of GST.
