These regulations may be cited as the *Trustee Companies Regulations 2026*.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on
27 September 2026.

3. Interpretation

In these regulations –

4. Prescribed amounts under section 10A of Act

- (1) For the purposes of section 10A(1)(c) of the Act, the prescribed amount is \$105 000.
- (2) For the purposes of section 10A(6)(a) of the Act, the prescribed amount is \$112 000.
