DAYLIGHT SAVING REGULATIONS 2017

I, the Lieutenant-Governor in and over the State of Tasmania and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, make the following regulations under the *Daylight Saving Act* 2007.

1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Daylight Saving Regulations 2017*.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on the day on which their making is notified in the *Gazette*.

3. Prescribed period for daylight saving

The period –

- (a) commencing at the hour of 2 a.m. (standard time) on the first Sunday in October in each year; and
- (b) ending at the hour of 3 a.m. (2 a.m. standard time) on the first Sunday in April in the following year –

is prescribed for the purposes of section 4 of the *Daylight Saving Act 2007*.
