1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Traffic* (Compliance and Enforcement) Amendment (Lane Filtering) Regulations 2017.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on 29 January 2018.

3. Principal Regulations

In these regulations, the *Traffic (Compliance and Enforcement) Regulations 2017** are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

4. Schedule 1 amended (Offences)

Schedule 1 to the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting after item 207 in Subdivision 24 of Division 2 of Part 1 the following item:
