1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Amendment (Identity Matching Services) Regulations 2017. Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Amendment (Identity Matching Services) Regulations 2017 Statutory Rules 2017, No. 113

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on the day on which their making is notified in the *Gazette*.

3. Principal Regulations

In these regulations, the Vehicle and Traffic (Driver Licensing and Vehicle Registration) Regulations 2010* are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

4. Regulation 125 amended (Security of information in registers)

Regulation 125 of the Principal Regulations is amended as follows:

- (a) by inserting the following paragraph after paragraph (d) in subregulation (2):
 - (da) if and as required for the purposes of identity matching services;
- (b) by inserting the following definition before the definition of *NEVDIS* in subregulation (3):
 - *identity matching services* means the scheme for the purpose of sharing and matching identity information established in accordance with the
