ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT AND POLLUTION CONTROL ORDER 2019

1. Short title

This order may be cited as the *Environmental Management and Pollution Control Order 2019*.

2. Commencement

This order takes effect on the day on which its making is notified in the *Gazette*.

3. Principal Act

In this order, the *Environmental Management and Pollution Control Act 1994** is referred to as the Principal Act.

4. Schedule 2 amended (Level 2 Activities)

Schedule 2 to the Principal Act is amended by omitting item 5 and substituting the following item:

5. Extractive Activities

- (a) Quarries: the extraction of 5,000 cubic metres or more of rock or gravel per year if the extraction –
 - (i) is the subject of, or requires, a mining lease under the *Mineral Resources Development Act 1995*; or
 - (ii) is carried out at a quarry in a State forest, within the meaning of the *Mineral Resources Development Act 1995*.
- (b) Extractive pits: the extraction of 5,000 cubic metres or more of sand or clay per year if the extraction is the subject of, or requires, a mining lease under the

Mineral Resources Development
Act 1995.

- (c) Mines: the extraction of any minerals producing 1 000 tonnes or more of minerals per year.
