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THREATENED SPECIES PROTECTION ORDER 2019

I make the following order under section 13(5) of the *Threatened Species Act 1995*.

1. Short title

This order may be cited as the *Threatened Species Protection Order 2019*.

2. Commencement

This order takes effect on the day on which its making is notified in the *Gazette*.

3. Principal Act

In this order, the *Threatened Species Protection Act 1995** is referred to as the Principal Act.
