1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the

Regulations 2021*.

3. Principal Regulations

In these regulations, the *Emergency Management Regulations 2020** are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

4. Regulation 4 amended (Infringement notice offences)

Regulation 4 of the Principal Regulations is amended as follows:

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) “section 60(c) of the Act” and substituting “section 60(c) or (d) of the Act”;
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (b)(i) “4.5 penalty units” and substituting “9 penalty units”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations amend the *Emergency Management Regulations 2020* by –

- (a) enabling an infringement notice to be issued in respect of the offence of providing false or misleading information to an emergency management worker; and
- (b) increasing the penalty that may be payable by an individual in respect of an infringement notice under the *Emergency Management Act 2006*.
