1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Australian Consumer Law (Tasmania) Regulations 2022*.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on 14 March 2022.

3. Prescribed related Acts

For the purposes of the definition of *related Act* in section 3(1) of the *Australian Consumer Law* (*Tasmania*) *Act 2010*, the following Acts are prescribed as related Acts:

- (a) Collections for Charities Act 2001;
- (b) *Conveyancing Act 2004*;
- (c) Co-operatives National Law (Tasmania) Act 2015;
- (d) Disposal of Uncollected Goods Act 2020;
- (e) Motor Vehicle Traders Act 2011;
- (f) Prepaid Funerals Act 2004;
- (g) Property Agents and Land Transactions Act 2016;
- (h) Residential Tenancy Act 1997;
- (i) Retirement Villages Act 2004;
- (j) Security and Investigations Agents Act 2002.
