**1. Short title**

These regulations may be cited as the *Traffic  
(Compliance and Enforcement) Amendment  
(Offence Detection Devices) Regulations 2023*.

**2. Commencement**

**3. Principal Regulations**

In these regulations, the *Traffic (Compliance and Enforcement) Regulations 2017\** are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

**4. Regulation 7 amended (Specified offences for section 54(1AA) of Act)**

Regulation 7(b) of the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting “portable device offence, seatbelt offence, registration offence,” after “light offence,”.

**5. Schedule 1 amended (Offences)**

Division 2 of Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Principal Regulations is amended as follows:

- (a) by inserting after item 363 in Subdivision 43 the following:
