1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Traffic* (Compliance and Enforcement) Amendment (Offence Detection Devices) Regulations 2023.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on the day on which the Vehicle and Traffic Amendment

(Driver Distraction and Speed Enforcement) Act 2022 commences.

3. Principal Regulations

In these regulations, the *Traffic (Compliance and Enforcement) Regulations 2017** are referred to as the Principal Regulations.

4. Regulation 7 amended (Specified offences for section 54(1AA) of Act)

Regulation 7(b) of the Principal Regulations is amended by inserting "portable device offence, seatbelt offence, registration offence," after "light offence,".

5. Schedule 1 amended (Offences)

Division 2 of Part 1 of Schedule 1 to the Principal Regulations is amended as follows:

(a) by inserting after item 363 in Subdivision 43 the following:

363A. RR Driver fail to wear properly adjusted and fastened seatbelt (when vehicle moving/stationary, but not parked) (photographic detection device)

(b) by inserting after item 365 in Subdivision 43 the following:
