### **1. Short title**

These regulations may be cited as the *Criminal Investigation (Extra-Territorial Offences) Regulations 2023*.

### **2. Commencement**

These regulations take effect on 18 December 2023.

**3. Interpretation**

In these regulations –

*Act* means the *Criminal Investigation (Extra-Territorial Offences) Act 1987*.

**4. Application of police officer**

An application of a police officer under section 4 of the Act is to be in accordance with Schedule 1.

**5. Search warrant**

A search warrant issued by a magistrate under section 4 of the Act is to be in accordance with Schedule 2.

**6. Notice of execution of search warrant**

A notice prepared by a police officer under section 5(6)(a) of the Act is to be in accordance with Schedule 3.
