1. Short title

These regulations may be cited as the *Criminal Investigation* (Extra-Territorial Offences) Regulations 2023.

2. Commencement

These regulations take effect on 18 December 2023.

3. Interpretation

In these regulations –

Act means the Criminal Investigation (Extra-Territorial Offences) Act 1987.

4. Application of police officer

An application of a police officer under section 4 of the Act is to be in accordance with Schedule 1.

5. Search warrant

A search warrant issued by a magistrate under section 4 of the Act is to be in accordance with Schedule 2.

6. Notice of execution of search warrant

A notice prepared by a police officer under section 5(6)(a) of the Act is to be in accordance with Schedule 3.
