**1. Short title**

This order may be cited as the *Government Procurement Review (International Free Trade Agreements) (Relevant Government Agencies) Order 2024*.

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**2. Commencement**

This order takes effect on the day on which its making is notified in the *Gazette*.

**3. Interpretation**

In this order –

*Act* means the *Government Procurement Review (International Free Trade Agreements) Act 2019*.

**4. Relevant government agencies**

For the purposes of section 4(1) of the Act, the following entities are declared to be relevant government agencies:

- (a) Homes Tasmania, established by section 9 of the *Homes Tasmania Act 2022*;
- (b) the Macquarie Point Development Corporation, established by section 5 of the *Macquarie Point Development Corporation Act 2012*.

**5. Accountable authority of relevant government agencies**

For the purposes of section 4(2) of the Act –

- (a) the chief executive officer of Homes Tasmania appointed under section 19 of the *Homes Tasmania Act 2022* is

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declared to be the accountable authority  
of Homes Tasmania; and

- (b) the chief executive officer of the  
Macquarie Point Development  
Corporation appointed under section 15  
of the *Macquarie Point Development  
Corporation Act 2012* is declared to be  
the accountable authority of the  
Macquarie Point Development  
Corporation.
