1. Short title

This order may be cited as the *Inland Fisheries (Seasons and Waters) Amendment Order 2025*.

2. Commencement

This order takes effect on the day on which its making is notified in the *Gazette*.

3. Principal Order

In this order, the *Inland Fisheries (Seasons and Waters) Order 1996** is referred to as the Principal Order.

4. Clause 4 amended (Taking of acclimatised fish)

Clause 4(1)(f) of the Principal Order is amended as follows:

- (a) by inserting the following subparagraph before subparagraph (i):
 - (iaa) Bradys Lake, except Woodward's Canal; and
- (b) by inserting the following subparagraph after subparagraph (v):
 - (va) Lake Binney; and
- (c) by inserting in subparagraph (xiii) "and" after "Tamar;"
- (d) by inserting the following subparagraph after subparagraph (xiii):
 - (xvi) Tungatinah Lagoon;

5. Clause 7 amended (Taking fish in certain waters)

Clause 7 of the Principal Order is amended by omitting subclause (1A).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the order)

This order amends the *Inland Fisheries (Seasons and Waters) Order 1996* to –

- (a) enable acclimatised fish to be taken from Bradys Lake, Lake Binney and Tungatinah Lagoon all year round; and
- (b) remove the restriction on who is permitted to take fish from Plenty River.
